

non-compliant as they have not yet been able to make progress on their deficiencies. A further two have been given an extended time to request a supplementary report until December 2015 due to difficult economic political or social situations in their respective countries.]

As ever, the Global Forum worked at a rapid pace to meet its schedule of peer reviews. 41 reports were published this year. As of October 2015, 86 jurisdictions have received ratings after the completion of their phase 2 reviews, of which 74 are rated as compliant or largely compliant. A further three jurisdictions have been exceptionally rated as Non-Compliant, as above. The results of the peer review for each jurisdiction reviewed so far are shown in the table below. More detail on the publication of reports for each jurisdiction is found in Annex 1.
