



# Tax good governance in the world as seen by EU countries

A number of EU Member States assess how countries and territories around the world apply standards of tax good governance (transparency, exchange of information, and fair tax competition). The **criteria** (partly common and partly their own) used by the relevant EU countries in their assessment are listed . The **following map** shows the results based on Member States lists in December 2014. The Commission will amend this list at least once a year to reflect changes to Member States' national lists.

*Click on a country or territory to see which EU countries (if any) consider it as non-compliant.*
